**JUL 2, 2022: OVERNIGHT FLIGHT** Departure from the United States.

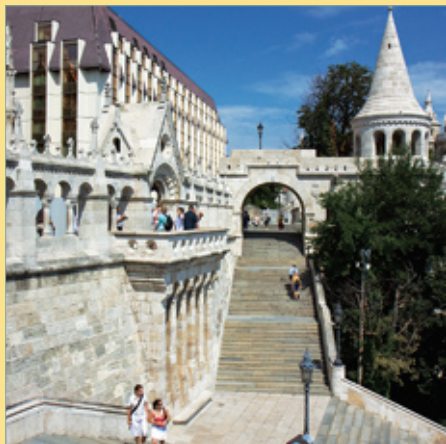

**JUL 9, 2022: GYOR** This morning, check out and transfer to Gyor, a city that lies on one of the prominent routes of Central Europe, halfway between Budapest and Vienna, where the Danube, Raba and Rabca rivers meet. Gyor's well-preserved and restored Old Town and Royal Town comprise one of the most beautiful Renaissance and Baroque townscapes to be found anywhere in Hungary. Enjoy guided sightseeing including the Cathedral Basilica of the Assumption of Our Lady with the famous painting Weeping Madonna of Gyor and the main square. Enjoy dinner on your own this evening. (B)

**JUL 10, 2022: GYOR** Today you will visit one of the oldest historical monuments in Hungary, the 1,000-year-old Pannonhalma Archabbey, a UNESCO World Heritage site. The abbey and adjacent Benedictine secondary school are situated high above the village on Szent Marton Hill. Return to Gyor for tonight's performance at the Old Synagogue (pending approval). Dinner is on your own tonight. (B)

**JUL 11, 2022: BUDAPEST** Transfer to Hungary's capital, Budapest, one of Europe's most cosmopolitan cities, where Eastern and Western influences have coexisted for centuries. The Turks occupied Budapest for 150 years, and popular Turkish spas can be found throughout the city, the most famous in the Gellert Hotel. With the grandest of all Parliament buildings in Europe, there's the sense you're in the center of Europe. You'll see some of the city's cultural and historical highlights during your guided tour: the grand Hero's Square and the Citadella atop Gellert Hill, Buda's Castle District, a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site; the beautiful Matthias Church and the neo-Romanesque Fishermen's Bastion. Rehearse this afternoon for tonight's final concert performance in St. Anna's Church (pending approval)! Dinner will be on your own. (B)

**JUL 12, 2022: BUDAPEST** Your final day is free for your own explorations; stroll through the city and discover quiet courtyards, markets, vintage pharmacies, and medieval walls as well as magnificent churches, palaces and museums.
