



## ENGL 4407/5407: "LONDON THEATRE"-Study Abroad May 12-27, 2020



**DESCRIPTION:** ENGL 4407/5407: "London Theatre" is a 3 credit hour, serious look at historic and modern theatre, requiring reading, observing, and critical writing. "London Theatre" takes place in central London during pre-summer session. Students will spend two weeks attending specific live performances, participating in arranged discussion groups, and visiting historical sites and museums. After returning to Tri-Cities, students have a week to complete their assignments.
